

Procedures and Conditions of Granting Scholarships, and Other Rules for Students' Financial Assistance in Avrasya Batumi International University,

Scholarship Rules

Article 1. General Provisions

1. This rule determines the procedures and conditions of awarding scholarships at Avrasya Batumi International University (hereinafter "Teaching University" "Abu"). As well as other rules of financial support for students.

Article 2. Academic Scholarship

1. Academic scholarship at the Teaching University is prescribed by the rector's order for bachelor's degree students.

2. The purpose of establishment of academic scholarship is to encourage students of the university for successful engagement in academic work, scientific work and university life.

3. Conditions for granting academic scholarships

3.1. The academic scholarship will be issued in each semester (prescribed), based on the results of the previous academic semester.

3.2. Scholarships will not be awarded in the following cases:

- a) For the first semester student;
- b) For the student who has spent more than the period specified in the basic education program at the relevant higher education level;
- c) For a student who is mobilized in the current semester;
- d) For the student who regained his / her status in this semester
- e) For the student who already has a scholarship or other university financing;
- f) For the student who is going to stop / terminate his education during the semester or who violate the regulations of the university.

4. Academic Scholarship Procedure

4.1. The decision on the appointment of the scholarship, based on the recommendation of the Faculty Board, takes the rector, which, within two weeks after the commencement of each academic semester, determines the number of seats and scholarships awarded by the order.

4.2. The selection of candidates for financing academic scholarship is carried out by the Board of Educational Institutions (hereinafter "Faculty Council")

4.3. The Information Technology Service is obliged to provide the Faculty Council with information about students with the best academic degree of bachelor's degree.

4.4. The Faculty Council shall take into consideration the following criteria for calculating the rating of the Bachelor's Degree Candidates for financing academic scholarship:

High academic performance:

A) more than GPA 3.0;

B) lack of academic indebtedness;

C) Obtain a credit in the subject without additional exam (except when the student wants to improve the final score).

- Participation in conferences in projects implemented on behalf of the Teaching University (+ 1 point);
- Participation in cultural and sporting events (+ 0,5 points);
- Participation in student self-government activities (+ 0,5 points);
- Fulfillment of financial liabilities to the Teaching University (+ 0.5 points)

5. Information on granting academic scholarship

5.1. The scholarship will be awarded to the most successful students of the university, the number of scholarship places allocated by the Rector in the given semester.

5.2. The scholarship is given once a month for 3 months.

Article 3. Social Scholarship

1. Social scholarship is allocated to socially vulnerable and financially disadvantaged students.
2. Based on the recommendations of the Chairman of the Faculty Board / Student Self-Government, the Rector of the International University of Batumi determines the amount of social scholarship and scholarship.

Article 4. Other Encouragement

1. The Rector of International University implements various financial support activities on the basis of its initiatives or student's request to improve student life.

Article 5. Final Provisions

1. The rules for academic and social scholarship and other types of incentives are approved by the Academic Council of the Teaching University.
2. The amendments to this Rule shall be made by the Academic Council.
