

The principle of the social program implementation of the Avrasya Batumi International University

Article 1. The aim of the program

The aim of the program is to grant the benefits envisaged in this Rule and Conditions in Payment of Tuition Fee for Socially Unprotected Students in accordance with the Statute of the Law of Georgia on Higher Education (Hereinafter "Teaching University").

Article 2. The goals of the program

The goal of the program is to identify the student who has the right to receive tuition fees and to determine the categories of benefits.

Article 3. Measures of the Program

1. In the implementation of the program, a commission formed by the decision of the Rector is applied.
2. Before the beginning of the term, the Commission determines the deadline for the implementation of the program and publishes a statement on the implementation of a special training program.
3. The declarations of the Commission is evaluated separately according to the determined criteria and the decision shall be submitted to the Rector in order to give a legal process (decision) regarding the payment of tuition fees.
4. In order to participate in the program, students must present the following documents in the editorial office.
 - a) Petition
 - b) A copy of the identity card (passport) and birth certificate of the Georgian citizen
 - c) The document issued by the faculty about student's academic performance
 - d) A copy of the registration document in the unified database of socially poor families (ranking points equal to or less than 100,000)
 - e) Medical certificate which shows the disability severely/ significantly/ moderately
 - f) A copy of the certificate issued by the Office of Veterans Affairs of Georgia, which confirms that the student is the child of the victim in the struggle for territorial integrity of Georgia, or a copy of the document given by the Georgian Ministry of Exiled People, Refugees and Accommodation indicating that the parent of the student was missing in the struggle for territorial integrity in Georgia.
 - g) A copy of the parent's death certificate (with the original)
 - h) Copies of the ID card of the student who is a member of a large family (family with many children).
 - i) A copy of the status certificate of person who was exiled in Georgia and issued by the Georgian Ministry of Exiled People, Refugees and Accommodation
 - j) Certificate of damage in the first or second category of the house of the Eco-immigrant (damaged natural disaster) given by the state institution with the relevant qualification
 - k) A document given by the state institution with the relevant qualification proving that the student is a single mother

Article 4. Funding of the Program

The Budget of the Teaching University is the source of funding for a special education program.

Article 5. People participating in the Program

Participants of the program are students of the academic program of higher academic education at the University of Teaching. The students who receive financial benefits from the Teaching University can not participate in the program.

Article 7. Assessment criteria

1-The benefits of the program shall be given below:

- a) Students who are registered in the unified database of socially unprotected families (ranking points equal to or less than 100,000) and who have received good grades (81 and more points) in all disciplines according to the results of the previous semester;
- b) Student who has a severely / significantly / moderately disabling capacity and who has evaluated "good" (71 and more points) in all disciplines according to the previous semester results;
- c) Students living in a family who were killed in war for the territorial integrity of Georgia or lost in the war for the territorial integrity of Georgia and who received a very good grades (81 or more points) in the previous period, according to the results obtained in all academic disciplines;
- d) The student, who is orphan (mother or father) and who has received good grades (81 and more points) according to the results of the previous semester in all disciplines;
- e) A student who is internally displaced and who has received good grades (81 and more points) in all disciplines according to the previous semester results;
- f) A student who has a multi-family (three children) and who has received a grade (91 and more points) in all disciplines according to the results of the previous semester;
- g) A student who is a member of a large family (four or five children) and who has received good grades (81 and more points) in all disciplines according to the results of the previous semester;
- h) Students who are members of a large family (six and more children) and who have taken the following evaluations according to the results of the previous semester;
 - * The arithmetic average of the assessment in all disciplines is 65 points or higher;
 - *Assessment received in all disciplines is less than 65 points;
 - * The arithmetic average of the assessment in all disciplines is 71 points or higher;
 - * The arithmetic average of the assessment in all disciplines is 81 points or higher;
- i) The student who has an eco-immigrant (disaster-affected) family determined by the related government agency and whose material damage is estimated in the first or second category due to disasters and who has an arithmetic average of 71 or higher in all disciplines according to the results of the previous period;

i) The student, who is a single mother which is certified by the state agency with the relevant competence and, who has received less than 65 points in all disciplines according to the results of the previous semester;

2- For the purpose of determining the percentage of funding, the criteria set by the program are defined by the specified scores.

2.1. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "a" of paragraph 1 of this article:

a) 30 points - Socially unprotected;

b) 70 points - 91 points and more.

c) 50 points - 81 points and more

2.2. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "b" of paragraph 1 of this article:

a) 30 points severely / significantly / moderately disability status

b) 70 points - 81 points and more.

c) 50 points - 71 points and more.

2.3. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "c" of paragraph 1 of this article:

a) 30 points - the situation of the child whose family is dead in the struggle for the territorial integrity of Georgia or lost in the struggle for the territorial integrity of Georgia;

b) 70 points - 91 points and more.

c) 50 points - 81 points and more

2.4. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "d" of paragraph 1 of this article:

a) 30 points - orphaned by the death of her parents

b) 70 points - 91 points and more.

c) 50 points - 81 points and more

2.5. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "e" of paragraph 1 of this article:

a) 30 Points - Status of Internally Displaced Persons

b) 70 points - 91 points and more.

c) 50 points - 81 points and more.

2.6. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "f" of paragraph 1 of this article:

a) 30 points - family of three (three children) family;

b) 70 points - 91 points and more

2.7. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "g" of paragraph 1 of this article:

- a) 30 points - family with four children (four to five children);
- b) 70 points - 91 points and more
- c) 50 points - 81 points and more.

2.8. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "h" of paragraph 1 of this article:

- a) 30 points - a large family (six and more children);
- b) 70 points - 91 points and more average arithmetic.
- c) 50 points - 71 points and more average arithmetic.
- d) 50 points - 61 points and more average arithmetic.

2.9. The following criteria are envisaged by the subparagraph "i" of paragraph 1 of this article:

- a) 30 points - Ecological immigrant (affected by disaster), family whose house has been damaged in the first or second category;
- b) 70 points - 81 points and more
- c) 50 points - 71 points and more

2. Based on the determined criteria and the sum of the collected points, the student will be given the following amounts:

- a) For a student with a score of 91 or higher and who has one of the specified social criteria, 100% of the term fee will be financed;
- b) A student who receives 81 and more points with the category of social criteria defined in two categories is financed %70 funding, the student having three social category is financed %100.
- c) For a student with a score of 81 or higher who has one of the specified social criteria, 50% of the term fee will be financed;

3. In case of social category envisaged by subparagraphs "b" and "h" of paragraph 1 of this article, the amount of student financing is determined by the following academic performance:

- a) A student who has a severely / significantly / moderately disability and who has received good grades (71 and more points) in all disciplines according to the results of the previous semester is given %100 funding for term fee.
- b) For a student who is a member of a family of six (more than six children) and a student with a score of 81 or higher in the arithmetic average of the assessment in all disciplines, the funding will be defined as 100% of the term fee;
- c) For a student who is a member of a family of six (more than six children) and a student with a score of 71 or higher in the arithmetic average of the assessment in all disciplines, the funding will be defined as 70% of the term fee;

d) For a student who is a member of a family of six (more than six children) and a student with a score of 65 or higher in the arithmetic average of the assessment in all disciplines, the funding will be defined as 50% of the term fee;

e) For the student whose multi-family (six or more children) and the arithmetic average of the assesment in all disciplines is less than 65 points, the funding will be defined as $\frac{1}{3}$ of the term fee;

f) For the student who s a single mother and whose arithmetic average is less than 65 points in all disciplines, the funding will be feined as $\frac{1}{3}$ of the term fee;
